

From the Editor's Desk

































BOOKS

A WEEK WITH THE SEVEN SISTERS

Northeast India is the easternmost region of India representing both a geographic and political administrative division of the country. It was my long cherished dream to visit this part of India. We started the journey from Mumbai on 11.02.2018 and reached Shillong, our first destination on 13.02.2018. Shillong, the capital city of Meghalaya takes you through all different types of climates. On our first day of touring, we went to Elephant Falls which is known for its elephant shaped rocks and Clearwater. After that we went to a point where the rivers of the seven sisters (Meghalaya, Nagaland, Tripura, Mizoram, Manipur, Assam, Arunachal Pradesh) meet. The place was covered with fog and the cool breeze swept all our tiredness away. Then we went exploring the Mawsmai caves

The stones inside the cave were slippery and we fell down many time. It was complete darkness inside and then with the help of torch lights we finally reached the end point. There we learned the importance of cooperation and value of others as we were able to reach our destination with the help of many who weren't known to us. This cave was near to Cherrapunji, the place which receives maximum rainfall. We were fortunate as we went there during the end of the winter season. Cherrapunji during that season got dried up. From our first day's experience we were all eager to explore more places with new experiences. On our 2nd day in Shillong we first went to Dawki River which offered a boating service between two countries i.e, India and Bangladesh. The river spreads over both the countries and makes people from both the countries meet as the boating starts from India and it stops for a minute in the land of Bangladesh. But we aren't allowed to stand in the land. The boating was a breathtaking experience. Next we went to the India-Bangladesh border and there we saw the bond of friendship between the two countries. The countries are separated by a gate. Then we went to a village named Mawlynnong, known as cleanest city in India. The village also holds a place among the World's cleanest cities. The food and love of the people add more to its beauty. Plastic is banned here. Proper disposal of waste is another important thing. They served us delicious food and we ate to our heart's content. Then we went to the Living roots bridge which is made by the tribal community of Khasi, which they used to walk carrying log for domestic purposes.

The bridge was built with the roots of two trees which still exist today and people all around the world visit this place as it is a naturally built bridge ever. Photography is allowed but sitting or standing on the bridge is banned to prevent any kind of damage to this natural wonder. This was all about the day. In the evening we had a walk across the market street of Shillong where we could hear people bargaining all around. On the 3rd day we went to the Ward's lake (artificial lake), which is named after the then Chief Commissioner of Assam, Sir William Ward. The lake was originally his idea. It was Later constructed in the year 1894 by Colonel Hopkins. The lake is complemented by a botanical garden. Then we went to one of the boating sites in Shillong. After boating, we went to the Don Bosco museum. There we saw a wide variety of instruments, dress, ornaments, study on different tribal communities, cultures and more. Study about Christianity and names of missionaries who sacrificed for the betterment of the state were also mentioned along with the sacraments. We carried beautiful memories of Shillong as we continued our journey to Guwahati, Assam.

Kamakhya temple is situated in Guwahati town. After visiting the temple, we went to the Kaziranga national park which is known for its one-horned rhinos. We had a jeep safari to the inner side of the forest and we saw many animals including the elephants, zebras, rhinos and pigs. Migratory birds were also seen in this place. Then we went to the Umananda temple which is situated between two islands. We went to the cave in a boat. Since it was evening time, only the priest was seen there. Monkeys were more in number than humans there!! The capital cities have different atmospheres and crowds. In Shillong we could experience a silent atmosphere with a pleasant weather whereas in Guwahati, we experienced the lives of busy people and a different weather with lots humidity. On the next day, we started our journey from Guwahati to Kerala after conveying our sincere gratitude to all who made this trip memorable for us.
